May G graciously com[m]iserate my sorrowf. state! sanctifie y<sup>s</sup> Dispensation, relieve me or prepare me for wt will

be next;  $y^t$  I may be wholly resigned! — Respecting  $y^e$  Man<sup>r</sup> & Circumst<sup>ce</sup> of my Living, they are very different.
