Worcester Ss To Ithemer Bellows Constable of Westboró Greeting Where as y^e Selectmen of S^d Westboró are Informed that there is of Late a poor woman Come from Sudbury To Reside or dwell in S^d Town of Westboró Namely Martha Palmer¹ and where as She may be Chargable to S^d Town of Westboró These are therefore to order you the S^d Constable forthwith to Notifie and warn y^e S^d Martha Palmer if She may be found in your Precinct forthwith to depart out of S^d Town of Westboró and leave makeing y^e S^d Town of Westboró y^e place of her abode any Longer and make Return of this warrant your doings here on unto y^e Town Clerk for S^d Westboró as Soon as may be dated at Westboró a fore S^d this fourteenth day of April A.D 1760

By Virtue of this warrant I have warned y^e woman within mentioned forthwith to depart the Town of Westboró as is Set forth in S^d warrant on y^e 23 of July 1760
