

## Warning Out Martha Palmer from Westborough, 1760

Worcester Ss To Ithemor Bellows Constable of Westboró Greeting Where as y<sup>e</sup> Selectmen of S<sup>d</sup> Westboró are Informed that there is of Late a poor woman Come from Sudbury To Reside or dwell in S<sup>d</sup> Town of Westboró Namely Martha Palmer<sup>1</sup> and where as She may be Chargable to S<sup>d</sup> Town of Westboró These are therefore to order you the S<sup>d</sup> Constable forthwith to Notifie and warn y<sup>e</sup> S<sup>d</sup> Martha Palmer if She may be found in your Precinct forthwith to depart out of S<sup>d</sup> Town of Westboró and leave making y<sup>e</sup> S<sup>d</sup> Town of Westboró y<sup>e</sup> place of her abode any Longer and make Return of ~~this warrant~~ your doings here on unto y<sup>e</sup> Town Clerk for S<sup>d</sup> Westboró as Soon as may be dated at Westboró a fore S<sup>d</sup> this fourteenth day of April A.D 1760
